ASIAN MASTERS SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS INDIA - 2026



1. Event Overview

The Asian Masters Swimming Championships 2026 will be held in India, bringing together Masters swimmers from across Asia to compete in a spirit of fitness, friendship, and excellence.

2. Venue Details

Competition Pool: 50m Olympic-size pool (10 lanes)

Warm-up Pool: 25m x 2

Timing System: Fully automatic electronic timing (Omega/equivalent)

Water Temperature: 25°C - 27°C

Seating Capacity: Approx. 1500

3. Competition Schedule

- Oct. 1st Arrival of teams & Registration
- Oct. 1st - 2nd Technical Meeting & Warm-up
- Oct. 3rd - 10th Competition Days
- Oct. 11th Departure

4. Eligibility

Open to all swimmers aged 25 years and above as of 31st December 2026.

Participants must represent a recognized club or federation affiliated with Asia Aquatics.

Each participant must submit:

- Valid passport copy
- Medical fitness certificate
- Entry through respective National Federation

6. Events

Individual Events:

Freestyle: 50m, 100m, 200m, 400m,

Backstroke: 50m, 100m, 200m

Breaststroke: 50m, 100m, 200m

Butterfly: 50m, 100m, 200m

Individual Medley: 200m, 400m

Relay Events:

4x50m Freestyle Relay

4x50m Medley Relay

Mixed 4x50m Freestyle Relay (as per Masters rules)

Mixed 4x50m Medley Relay (as per Masters rules)

7. Entry Rules

Each swimmer may enter:

Maximum 5 individual events

Maximum 2 relay events per day

Entry times must be submitted (no qualifying times required)

All entries must be submitted through National Federations



8. Entry Fees

- Individual Event Fee: USD 20 per event
- Relay Fee: USD 40 per team
- Registration Fee: USD 60 per swimmer

(Fees may be revised by the Organizing Committee)

9. Awards

Medals: Gold, Silver, Bronze for each age group

Certificates: Participation certificates for all swimmers

10. Accommodation & Transport

Official hotels will be announced with special tariffs

Airport transfers available for accredited participants

Shuttle services between hotels and venue

11. Key Deadlines

Preliminary Entries: 1st July 2026

Final Entries: 15th August 2026

Accommodation Deadline: 1st September 2026

Accreditation Deadline: 1st September 2026
